



Our not-for-profit housing association was created in 2000 in what was then the largest single housing stock transfer in the country. We are Coventry's biggest social housing provider, owning and managing more than 18,500 affordable homes across the City.

In 2009 Whitefriars joined Harden, Kemble and Nexus Housing Associations as a member of the West Mercia Housing Group, which is now known as WM Housing Group.

The Group is a regional force of more than 24,000 homes, a lead investment partner of the Homes & Communities Agency (HCA) and the lead member of the Spectrum Development Consortium. Each year we build around 300 new homes and invest over £29 million to ensure that our communities are places where people are proud to live and work.
